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Advancements in Diabetes Care: Beyond Glycemic Control

The focus in managing diabetes now has extended beyond regulating blood sugar level to encompass cardiovascular (CV) and renal risk reduction. Recent cardiovascular outcome trials (CVOT) and subsequent studies highlight the cardiorenal benefits of newer antihyperglycemic medications for both patients with or without diabetes.

For patients at high risk or with established atherosclerotic cardiovascular disease, the emphasis has shifted towards preventing cardio adverse events alongside glycemic control. Sodium-glucose cotransporter 2 inhibitors (SGLT2i) and glucagon-like peptide 1 receptor agonists (GLP1 RA) have shown favorable effects in cardiorenal protection and improved cardiac outcomes in multiple CVOTs.

In patients with chronic kidney disease, SGLT2i can significantly slow disease progression, offering benefits even up to dialysis.

Similarly, in patients with diabetes and comorbid heart failure, SGLT2i can decrease the risk of hospitalization for heart failure.
