SURGE IN CONGENITAL SYPHILIS CASES IN ILLINOIS ESSENTIAL GUIDANCE AND RESOURCES FOR HEALTHCARE PROVIDERS

The Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) reported a threefold increase in congenital syphilis cases since 2020. In response, IDPH established a dedicated phone line (800-439-4079) to offer clinical guidance for providers managing syphilis. IDPH strongly recommends that all patients who are pregnant undergo syphilis testing to ensure treatment is initiated at least 30 days before delivery. If untreated, syphilis can result in severe, permanent damage, or even death, in infants. Due to the current shortage of penicillin G benzathine, providers are advised to familiarize themselves with alternative treatment options for adult patients who are not pregnant.
